Test Description	<p>Firms will submit dummy orders for pre-determined products to the Montreal Exchange (MX). MX will validate the receipt of these orders as defined in the transaction acknowledgement protocol field below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - MX participants can use the following protocols for order entry: FIX, SAIL - Market data will be disseminated via multicast HSVF & OBF feeds. - Also available for testing – ATR, Drop Copy, TMS, Clearing API, MX FTP/SFTP server (EOD and PAR Reports), LOPR. <p>Trade data will flow through from MX to CDCC’s SOLA® Clearing system (Connectivity – trade processing for clearing),</p> <p>Within CDCC’s Disaster Recovery (DR) environment, Clearing Members would be able to enter the system following login in, access and visualize trades.</p> <p>Please note that the CDCC reports reflecting DR clearing activities will be provided following the end-of-day batch of Monday, October 26, 2020.</p> <p>As access to the CDCC Secured FTP (sFTP) Server will be available, CDCC would request that Clearing Members attempt to access the latter in a DR-mode and advise CDCC staff if their file directory was readily accessible (Clearing Members can send an email to cdcc-ops@tmx.com).</p> <p>CDCC will likewise request those Clearing Members with a FIXML connection feed to please test their connectivity to this in a DR-mode, including the FIXML SFTP Server, and advise CDCC staff if everything was readily accessible (Clearing Members can send an email to cdcc-ops@tmx.com).</p>
