# Methodology

- FIA collects data on volume and open interest from 90 exchanges and clearinghouses around the world.
- Two exchanges added in 2023: Guangzhou Futures Exchange and Uruguay Futures Exchange
- Volume is measured in terms of the number of futures and options contracts traded and/or cleared per month
- Open interest is measured in terms of the number of contracts outstanding at the end of the month
- FIA publishes a monthly summary on its website and distributes the summary to FIA members

#### December 2023 Highlights

This month's data on futures and options trading is accessible in two formats: a spreadsheet accessible through the link below and a set of interactive visualizations called the **FIA ETD Tracker**. The ETD Tracker consists of interactive visualizations on the FIA website that allow users to view data on volume and open interest, with filters based on year and month, region and jurisdiction, asset group and type of product. The ETD Tracker also includes visualizations that rank exchanges by total volume in the latest month and year to date as well as open interest in the latest month. Worldwide volume of exchange-traded derivatives reached 15.17 billion contracts in December, the highest level ever recorded. This was up 8.4% from November 2023 and up 79.7% from December 2022.


Options continue to gain in popularity. Global trading of options reached 12.92 billion contracts in December, up by more than 114% from last year, with most of that trading taking place in the Asia-Pacific region. Global trading of futures reached 2.24 billion contracts in December, down 7.2% from the same month last year.






Global OI at end of 2023 was 1.25 billion contracts, up 51% from the same quarter five years ago



Quarter-End Open Interest by Region 2014 to 2023


### What Is Driving the Growth in Trading Volume?

In 2023, more than 84 billion equity index options traded on India's NSE and BSE. That was more than twice the total traded in the previous year, and more than 61% of all futures and options traded on exchanges worldwide.


### SPX Options – Rise of Zero Day to Expiration Options

Almost half of all SPX options traded in 2023 expired the same day, versus less than 25% two years ago.




% of SPX Volume by Time to Expiry




### **US Treasury Futures – Surge in Volume and Ol**

Total volume in Treasury futures reached 1.4 billion contracts in 2023, up 16% from 2022 and 42% from 2020. Open interest hit a record 21.4 million futures in November and ended the year at 19.3 million, up 35% from 2022.



#### SOFR Futures: Surpassing Peak Eurodollars

More than 1.28 billion SOFR futures and options traded on CME in 2023, surpassing the highest volume ever recorded for Eurodollar futures and options. Open interest also set a record, reaching 60.4 million contracts on December 12, including 48.3 million options and 12.1 million futures.


#### SOFR volumes in 2023 eclipse Eurodollars' all-time high


#### **Price Discovery**


Central banks' policy rates and market-implied rate trajectories






#### Crude Oil: ICE Brent Overtakes Nymex WTI

The increasing use of Brent as a benchmark for pricing global shipments of crude oil, combined with record US exports of crude oil, helped boost volume in ICE's Brent futures to a record 268 million contracts in 2023.

The addition of Monday and Wednesday expirations at the end of July has led to a notable increase in trading activity.







#### LME: Trading Volume Recovers from Nickel Crisis




LME Nickel Futures Volume and Open Interest










